1. Competition Dates

Padel competitions for Open Masters Games Como Lake 2027 (CoOMG27) offers the opportunity to compete for men and women in two events: Doubles and Mixed Doubles

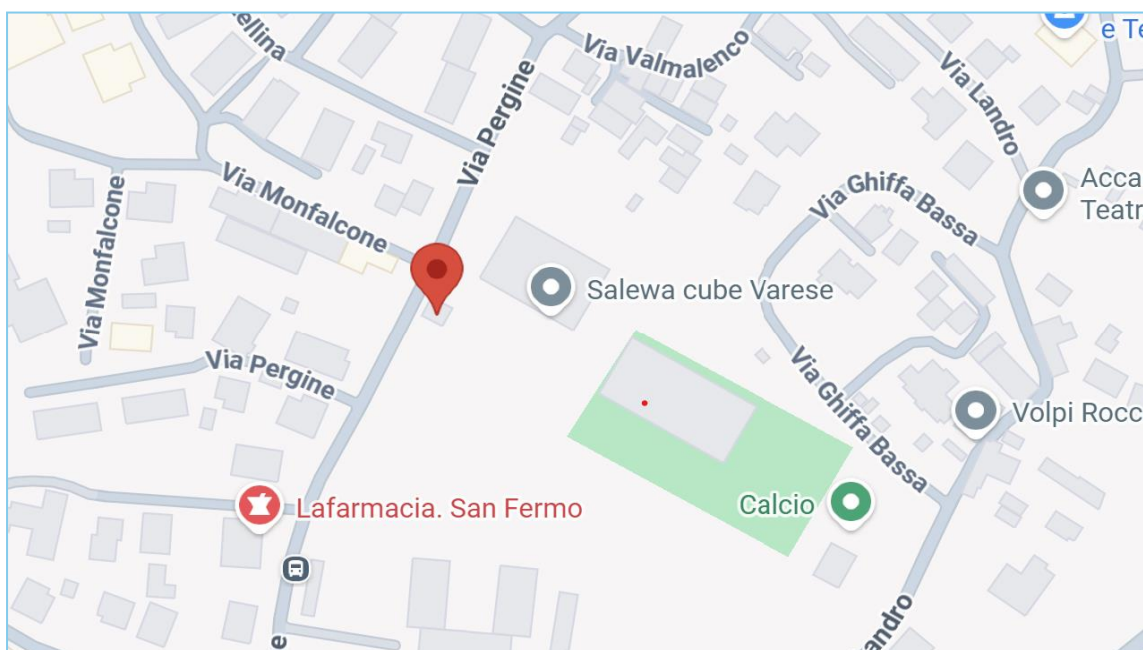

2. Age Categories

- Men: 30+, 40+, 50+, 60+, 65+, 70+, 75+
- Women: 30+, 40+, 50+, 60+, 65+, 70+, 75+

2.1 Age is determined on 31 December 2027.

- In the doubles pair, the age of the youngest player will determine the age category.

3. Sport regulations

Competitions will be conducted under the rules and regulations of the International Padel Federation (FIP) and or as specified in the sport guide. The competition will also be carried out in accordance with any special requirements of the World Masters Sport.

4. Type of Competition - Disciplines, Events & Grading

Discipline: Doubles Men, Women, Mixed

Grade Definition: Competitive and Recreational

- Competitive: This grade is for players with international or national experience or a high standard domestic level.
- Recreational: This grade is for players who participate in non-competitive and/or lower grade leagues and for social or casual purposes.

5. Competition format

Depending on the number of entries received in each age category, the Organising Committee reserves the right to adopt the most appropriate competition format in order to guarantee a balanced and efficient tournament schedule. Competitions may therefore be conducted either in a round robin format (groups of approximately four teams/pairs) or through a double elimination system, ensuring all participants are guaranteed more than one match.

Where the round robin format is adopted, matches will be played over two tie-break sets using the no-ad scoring system. In the event of one set all, a 10-point Match Tie-Break will be played in place of a third set.

6. Competition rules

- Each player can participate in one double and one mixed doubles event if the schedule allows.
- Doubles and mixed doubles pairs should enter the grade of the higher-level player.
- Each player can only compete in one age group.

Please Note: All regulation conditions concerning categories, venues, the running of the competition and technical aspects are applied on a provisional basis and are subject to change when and how the executive committee sees appropriate, up until the beginning of the competition.

7. Equipment

- Each player must arrive ready to play in appropriate kit (shorts or skirt, tennis shoes, t-shirt).
- Equipment used in the competition must conform with the International Padel Federation.
- Balls used must be those provided by the organization. There will be 3 per match and they must be returned at the end of the game.

8. Uniform

Each player must arrive ready to play in the appropriate playing kit.

9. Technical meeting

A Technical Meeting will take place before the start of the competition to introduce the tournament, remind those involved of the regulations and the behavior that is expected.

10. Technical Delegate

Technical Delegate endorsed by FIP will be announced in the final version of the Guide. The Technical Delegate will oversee the implementation of all sport specific rules and requirements at the Games.

11. Medals

In CoOMG27, the athletes do not represent their country of origin, therefore the prize-awarding ceremonies will be carried out without hoisting of flags. No National Anthem of the winning team will be played. The medal ceremony will be held after each final. The medals will be provided by the Organizing Committee.

12. Personal accident insurance and medical certificate

All participants must organize their personal accident insurance. The competitor registration fee does not cover personal accident insurance.

Personal accident insurance is available to purchase through the Organizing Committee for registered Competitors at the Accreditation Centre.

All participants must have a currently valid medical certificate of fitness for competitive sports.

The medical examinations required (ex D.M. 18 February 1982) to obtain a medical certificate of fitness for competitive sports are:

- medical check-up;
- regular urine test;
- electrocardiogram both at rest and under effort.
- spirometry (breathing test).

13. Doping Control

During the Open Masters Games Como Lake 2027 anti-doping controls will be carried out according to the World Masters Sport anti-doping policy and rules established by WADA (World Anti-Doping Agency).
