1. Competition Dates

Archery competitions for Open Masters Games Como Lake 2027 (CoOMG27) offer individual events for men and women.

The provisional Archery competitions schedule for CoOMG27 is as follows and could be subject to change according to the requirements of the Organising Committee, and may be modified according to the total number of entries:

The Welcome Ceremony is scheduled for the afternoon of Saturday, 18 September 2027, with the Farewell Ceremony on the evening of Sunday, 26 September 2027.

2. Sport Regulation

Competitions will be conducted under the rules and regulations of the World Archery Federation (WA) and in accordance with any special requirements of the International Masters Games Association. The detailed daily schedule for each discipline will be available only after the registration deadline.

2.1 Age Categories

- Men's and Women's: 30+, 40+, 50+, 60+, 70+
- Age is determined on 31 December 2027.
- Competitors can compete in one age category. In line with the sport-specific rules, an athlete can compete in a younger age group (any); however, can only enter one age category and one bow type per discipline.

3. Sport regulations

3.1 Type of Competition

- *Target competition* > **Recurve Bow**: Men and Women
 - Recurve bow age categories:
 - 30+, 40+ > (70 mt, target 122 cm);
 - 50+, 60+, 70+ > (60 mt, target 122 cm).
- *Target competition* > **Compound Bow**: Men and Women
 - Compound bow age categories:
 - 30+, 40+, 50+, 60+, 70+ (50 mt, target 80 cm, 6 rings)
- *Target competition* > **Barebow** (Recurve Barebow) -: Men and Women
 - Barebow age categories:
 - 30+, 40+, 50+, 60+, 70+ (50 mt, target 122 cm)
- *Para Archery Target Competition* > **Compound Bow (Open)** – **Recurve Bow (Open)**
 - Men's/Women's: 30+, 40+, 50+ - W1 (Open)
 - The disciplines may be combined, with the winners determined based on the points.
 - Age groups can be combined if required.
 - In the event of low registration numbers, the W1 event may be cancelled.
- *Field Competition*
 - WA standard distances for all competitors **Recurve, Compound**.
 - Men's/Women's: 30+, 40+, 50+, 60+, 70+

4. Competition format

Only individual competition: no team event is scheduled.

If there are insufficient entries in an age category, the category may be combined in order to conduct a viable competition. The awarding of medals will not be affected, that is individuals will still be awarded medals in the age category in which they originally entered.

4.1 Target Competition

- Qualification session: 72 arrows at age distance as for 3.1.
- Elimination Round at the same distance.
- All archers will have access to the match round: no cut-off.

4.2 Field Competition

- Qualification session: 12+12.
- Standard Field competition distances.
- Elimination Round: All archers will have access to the match round: no cut-off.

5. Competition Rules

The rules covering the rounds to be shot, equipment, clothing, advertising, and scoring for Target will be those of World Archery.

5.1 Target competition

- Match Round: Compound cumulative score; Recurve Set System.

5.2 Field competition

- Eliminations and finals will be shoot with the new Round System.

6. Equipment

Each competitor must provide his own equipment. All athletes are required to supply their own equipment and ensure it complies with the relevant rules. Equipment checks will be carried out by the Technical Delegate / Technical Officials. Athletes with non-conforming equipment will not be able to compete.

7. Uniforms

Dress code as WA Rules. No official Country uniforms are required.

8. Medals

In CoOMG27, the athletes do not represent their country of origin, therefore the prize-awarding ceremonies will be carried out without hoisting flags. No National Anthem of the winning Athletes will be played. The medals will be provided by the Organizing Committee.

9. Technical Meeting

A technical meeting will take place before the start of the competition to introduce the tournament, remind those involved of the regulations and the behaviour that is expected.

10. Practice and warm-up facilities

Practice range will be available for both venues.

If any athlete requires a practice session in days before the event, local clubs' venues will be available upon request.

11. Doping Control

During the Open Masters Games Como Lake 2027 anti-doping controls will be carried out according to the World Masters Sport anti-doping policy and rules established by WADA (World Anti-Doping Agency).

12. Personal accident insurance and medical certificate

All participants must organize their personal accident insurance. The competitor registration fee does not cover personal accident insurance.

Personal accident insurance is available to purchase through the Organizing Committee for registered Competitors at the Accreditation Centre.

All participants must have a currently valid medical certificate of fitness for competitive sports.

The medical examinations required (ex D.M. 18 February 1982) to obtain a medical certificate of fitness for competitive sports are:

- medical check-up;
- regular urine test;

- electrocardiogram both at rest and under effort;
- spirometry (breathing test).
